Hi Family, All commitments were met for the month of March, and all open commitments have been filled (yay!!). A volunteer in the Chaplin's office at the VB jail reached out to me about providing NA literature to the inmates. I brought it to the H&I body and a motion was made to provide 2 basic texts, 5 An Introductory Guide to NA booklets, and the Just for Today daily meditation book to the jail. All of these books are already in our possession. The motion also included a provision to use about \$8 a month out of our budget to order 10 white booklets to donate to the jail on a monthly basis. All this literature has already been approved by the Chaplin. The intent is to fulfill the 5th tradition to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.
